Remember earliest positive memory of worship	How does worship impact, shape and mold us?	What do you do in worship for the love of God?	Tell about traditions in your service that connect people; the ones that leave people out. Are you willing to change?	Are you willing to support a worship experience that is not your favorite to support a new person?	How do you experience authentic worship at home and church? Do you feel the presence of God beyond church?	Describe the “aha” moments in worship; how did it change your life and worship unto to God?
What do you think God wants from us when we worship?	Look at the bulletin from worship, what part connects you to God? What part connects everybody?	Pray for all the persons who help prepare and lead worship at your church? Pray for you to get passionate.	What ways do I connect? Reasons that I miss worship. Do I practice daily prayer and study of God’s Word?	Pray for someone in service that is a different age group, gender, or ethnicity to feel God’s presence.	Find (1) scripture from this week that can help you focus on getting in the presence of God daily.	Invite (1) person to worship. Come to worship with an attitude of praise; help someone to worship God!

Study Flow:

- Opening Prayer
- Paint the picture: Introduction about Lenten Season and the Study
- Ask about what does *Passionate Worship* mean to the individual, church body, and community
- Shape the study with weekly scriptures – Invite someone to read current day scripture / reading.

Thursday’s Scripture is Psalm 98: Sing to GOD a brand-new song. He’s made a world of wonders! He rolled up his sleeves, He set things right. God made history with salvation, He showed the world what he could do. He remembered to love us, a bonus. To his dear family, Israel—indefatigable love. The whole earth comes to attention. Look—God’s work of salvation! Shout your praises to God, everybody! Let loose and sing! Strike up the band! Round up an orchestra to play for God, add on a hundred-voice choir. Feature trumpets and big trombones, fill the air with praises to King God. Let the sea and its fish give a round of applause, with everything living on earth joining in. Let ocean breakers call out, "Encore!" And mountains harmonize the finale— A tribute to God when he comes, when he comes to set the earth right. He’ll straighten out the whole world, he’ll put the world right, and everyone in it. (**Message Translation**)

- Get into action: How do these passages invite each of us into action? As we pray for action, which scripture / devotion got your attention? What ways can you share worship with someone beyond Sunday? Pray for the persons from last week; Call 5 people to listen to their testimony.
- What’s next? Prayers for Community – Who will pray out loud?
